Current Program Costs

Effective Date: September 1, 2011 - August 31, 2012. Tuition per year is \$23,160. Tuition changes go into effect annually beginning with the Fall term. Other costs you can anticipate include books, articles, and supplies; costs associated with session and cluster attendance; and computer equipment and supplies. These vary by student. For new students: Beyond the \$75 application fee, the fee for the mandatory in-residence New Student Orientation is \$850, which covers registration and most meals. The registration fee for National, Clinical, and Research Sessions is \$295. New students are required to attend one National Session during the first year of enrollment.
