²Licensure data are collected via survey from alumni who are 2-10 years post graduation. The data are updated at least every three years. The percent licensed is the number of graduates known by us to be licensed divided by the total number of graduates from 9/1/1997-8/31/2005.

Current Program Costs

Effective Date: September 1, 2010 - August 31, 2011. Tuition per year is \$21,300. Tuition changes go into effect annually beginning with the Fall term. Other costs you can anticipate include books, articles, and supplies; costs associated with session and cluster attendance; and computer equipment and supplies. These vary by student. For new students: Beyond the \$75 application fee, the fee for the mandatory in-residence New Student Orientation is \$850, which covers registration and most meals. The registration fee for National, Clinical, and Research Sessions is \$295. New students are required to attend one National Session during the first year of enrollment.
